



## DISASTER ASSISTANCE INFORMATION

Friends, the State of South Carolina received a major federal disaster declaration for three counties in the Second Congressional District: Richland, Lexington and Orangeburg. This declaration means that families can receive individual assistance for:

- Temporary Housing Assistance
- Repair Assistance
- Replacement Assistance
- Permanent or Semi-Permanent Construction

### **What Now?**

Register your damage as soon as possible with FEMA:

- Visit: [www.m.fema.gov](http://www.m.fema.gov)
- Call: 1-800-621-3362

Contact your insurance company. Document the damage to your home, vehicle, and property with photos and videos. Help your neighbors get registered.

### **What happens next?**

FEMA will contact you and will send a representative to your home to inspect the damage. The approval process will take approximately 7 to 10 days.

### **What about schools, hospitals, and roads?**

Repairs to public buildings and critical infrastructure are covered under Public Assistance funding and will be requested by state and local governments.
